The Maryland SPCA operates out of one small campus in Baltimore. Donations and program fees make up 99%

of the SPCA's budget yet over 2,000 pets are rescued and adopted each year. Volunteers willing to show their love for animals by giving their time are also needed. If you are unable to adopt or foster an animal but want to help, you could offer to be a:

- Dog Deputy walking dogs in the shelter.
- Front Desk Concierge providing customer service for visitors in administrative and kennel settings.
- Kibble Connection Volunteer organizing and delivering pet food and supplies to families in their homes.
- Amazon Warrior joining staff members at Amazon distribution facilities to pick up donations for the SPCA.
- Cat Cuddler providing socialization and enrichment for cats needing homes.
- Event Volunteer representing the SPCA at community adoption and fundraising events.
