Malta - Our national website. https://malta.vfwauxiliary.org/


Podium book - Handbook of rules and rituals. Changes slightly from year to year.

- <u>Hospital</u> Visiting and encouraging vets who are in a hospital or long term medical care.
- Legislative Getting VFW endorsed bills passed and encouraging civic engagement.
- <u>Membership</u> Recruiting new members and encouraging membership renewals each year.
- <u>President's Special project</u> A cause or organization that the national and department president choose for us to support.
- <u>Public relations</u> Promoting auxiliary membership and activities to the public.
- <u>Scholarship</u> Promoting the 6 scholarships we offer throughout the year in art, singing, continuing education, writing, and spoken word.
- <u>Veteran and military support</u> Helping military families in the community.
- <u>Youth activities</u> Working with youth groups on patriotic or community projects.
