This month's message is about Mentoring. The benefits of mentoring can be invaluable to mentees, and they can have a correspondingly positive impact on the auxiliary. Yet too often mentoring falls flat; the Auxiliary fails to achieve these benefits. WHY? Because they don't follow Five Golden Rules!

- CHOOSE THE RIGHT MENTORS Problems will arise if the wrong people are chosen or if a mentor lacks proper time to devote to their mentees. An effective mentor is someone who can challenge and support a mentee and Not judge them. They should be adept at the Seven C's: coaching, be a confidante, act as a conduit to others, provide career advice (by teaching mentees the roles of the officers in your auxiliary), serve as a counsellor, be a critical friend, and provide the mentee with choice.
- 2. *MAKE IT APPEALING* -The sense of satisfaction from helping others to develop – and sharing in their successes can be a powerful motivator, particularly if mentors are positioned as esteemed individuals who are passing on knowledge within the auxiliary.
- MAKE IT VOLUNTARY The best approach is to ask admired, knowledgeable members to volunteer to become a mentor. Those who come forward will often have many of the qualities required for success.
- 4. PROVIDE TRAINING Potential mentors may need coaching to help them develop or sharpen the skills and attributes they need to succeed. Here's a Challenge: watch these 2 YouTube short videos – "What is Mentoring?" APM – Dec 7, 2022, and Mentoring (Inspirational Video) ThatCivilEngineer –Mar3, 2021. <u>The members who tell me</u> <u>what the last slide of the Mar 3, 2021, video says will go into a</u> <u>drawing for a nice prize!</u>

 MATCH THE RIGHT MENTOR TO THE RIGHT MENTEE – Personality, motivation, interests can help pair people. Certain mentees may want specific support or may have a special field of interest. Matching can lead to a successful relationship.
