

What is the Honors Escort Program?


Honors Escort is a brief ceremonial procession for Veterans at their hour of death in an institutionalized setting. It honors military Veterans who have unselfishly served our country. Honors Escort offers fellow Veterans, family members and staff a moment of reflection and creates a visual display of military heritage.

Many Veteran Affairs (VA) facilities have an Honors Escort in place. As a Veteran Service Organization volunteer, you may have participated in an Honors Escort ceremony at your local VA. Ceremonies may vary at each VA facility throughout the country.

Non-VA healthcare facilities take strides to honor Veterans, and while some facilities have a Honors Escort in place, others may not. It is said that there are **464,687** Veterans projected to die this year outside of VA medical facilities. Many of these Veterans will receive home hospice care in the community.
