


## 24-25 Auxiliary Outreach Program

Partner: Find an organization that is doing a community event.

Approve: Pass a motion at your Auxiliary meeting to partner with that organization for their success.

Participate: Assist the other organization with whatever they need.

Emblem: Wear items or apparel that identifies you as a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary.

Report: Send a report of the event to your Department Chairperson as well as to newspapers and post on social media using #Auxiliaryoutreach.

Sounds pretty simple, huh? Auxiliary Outreach does not have to be complicated. Just follow the above steps and you are sure to have a great report to turn in. With the holidays right around the corner, there are many groups that could use a few more helping hands with their endeavors and as Auxiliary members we stand willing and able to help our community be successful.
