Legislative—Invite your elective officials to attend your Veterans Day event. Present them with a corsage or boutonniere that includes "Buddy"® Poppies.

Membership— Veterans Day events are a creative tool to recruit new members. This is a great time to do a "Buddy"® Poppy Drive.

Scholarships—Now is the time to promote your Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest. Post flyers on local bulletin boards with "Buddy"® Poppies.

Veterans & Family Support—Send Thank You Cards to your Post Members recognizing them for their service and include a Poppy.
