With your donations, monetary or art supplies Patriot Point works with veterans and military service organizations to help guests heal through organized recreational activities.

The Patriot Point Lodge has 5 bedrooms and the Guest House has six bedrooms. Each house is equipped with a wheelchair lift. Each house has space for up to eight individuals and has a fully equipped kitchen for guests' use. Retreats vary from one night to one week.

In order to be eligible for a retreat, an organization must be an established veteran focused on non-profit who fall within our mission statement of “wounded, ill and injured service members. Their families and caregivers”.

Department President Debbie Sturgis’s goal is \$40,000 for Patriot Point.
