As of February 17th, 2025 we are 63% reported as a Department. I know that we can dig deep and get those last few Auxiliaries to submit reports.

- Also recently I have received more than a handful of blank reports or reports that say "No activities were conducted during this time period". It has been shared several times over the last few years that a "No report" is not an acceptable report.
- I've also heard from Auxiliaries lately that have also said "We can't get into the schools". You don't have to go into the schools to reach the youth.

Below is a list of "non-school" activities that can be submitted for reports

- Create a post library. Use the list from MALTA, Member Resources, Youth Activities, Suggested Book list or books that have been suggested in previous promotions to create a library where youth who attend your family style meals can access the books. You can get these books from Amazon, thrift stores, yard sales and other used book stores.
- 2. Check out your local public library and see if they have patriotic books in stock. If they do not see if your Auxiliary can donate some books off the list to the local library. Or contact the local school librarian to see if they would like to receive a donation of patriotic books.
- 3. There are many youth groups within our schools and community that we can support, sponsor, and work with.

These may include but are not limited to:

• The Scouts • Church Youth Groups • Boys & Girls Club • School Sponsored Groups • JROTC • After school programs

Some suggested ideas to get them involved:

• Placing Flags on graves • Helping serve meals at an event.

VFW Auxiliary National Art Contest Illustrating America Art Contest 2024-2025

VFW Auxiliary National is pleased to present this National art contest to introduce, encourage and recognize young artists with patriotism through art. Entries will be judged on patriotic theme and technique.

Contest Eligibility

- Student does not have to be related to a VFW or VFW Auxiliary member to participate
- Students in grades K-8 by March 31 deadline who are enrolled in a public, private, parochial or home school program in the United States, its territories and possessions, or dependents of U.S. military or civilian personnel in overseas schools.
- Although U.S. citizenship is not required, students must be lawful U.S. permanent residents or have applied for permanent resident (the application for which has not been denied) and intends to become a U.S. citizen.
- Foreign exchange students, students aged 15 or older are **not** eligible.
- Previous winners of VFW Auxiliary National Illustrating America Art Contests are **not** eligible for the same grade division of which they are a previous national winner. However, the students may enter the subsequent grade division.

Contest Rules

- Entry must be completed during the current school year.
- Entry must be two dimensional.
- Entry must be on canvas or paper.
- Canvas entries must be submitted on a stretcher frame or canvas board.
- Paper entries must be reinforced with heavy paper.
- Do not frame art with wood, metal, plastic or glass.
- Mats may be used, including mounted and floating mats.
- Entries may not be smaller than 8"x10" and not larger than 18"x24" including mat.
- Acrylic, chalk, crayon, ink, marker, pastel, pen, pencil, tempera, watercolor, glitter or other media may be used.
- If the American Flag is used, it does **not** need conform to the Federal Flag Code in relation to colors, numbers of stars and stripes and other pertinent rules of the code.
- Coloring sheets, digital art and photography are not accepted.
- Completed typed or printed legible entry form including parent and/or guardian signatures.
- Students name, age and grade level must be printed on back of art entry.

VFW Auxiliary is not responsible for entries which are lost, late, illegible, damaged, incomplete, misdirected, stolen, or reproduced. All scores are final as received from the judges. All contestants must agree to abide by the contest rules. Falsifying information on the entry form or any violation of these rules shall cause immediate disgualification and forfeiture of award.

VFW Auxiliary judging dates and deadlines:

- March 31: Student entries must be submitted to a participating sponsoring VFW Auxiliary for judging.
- **April 15**: First place winner from each grade division from participating sponsoring VFW Auxiliary or **optional** VFW Auxiliary District advances to the VFW Auxiliary Department (state) for judging.
- **May 5:** First place winner from grade division from each Department (state) due to VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters for judging.
- July/August: All students will be notified of entry status via email provided on entry form. First through third place winning entries in each grade division will be announced on VFW Auxiliary National social media pages and may be shown at the VFW Auxiliary National Convention.
- **September:** All art entries received at VFW Auxiliary National will be returned to students to the address provided on the entry form.
