# "Buddy"® Poppy"

We are coming down to the homestretch. Is your "Buddy"® Poppy Display almost completed? Here are important reminders about your display.

## **Department VFW "Buddy"® Poppy Display Contest**

- \*Takes place annually at Department Convention
- \*Displays are judged in three (3) categories:
- 1) Public Promotion of Poppy Campaign (Window, booth, parade, poster displays, campaign promotions, etc.).
- 2) Memorial or Inspirational Displays (Wreaths, memorial tablets or plaques, patriotic or devotional themes)
- 3) Artistic or Decorative Use of Poppies (Post Home displays, table centerpieces, corsages)
- \*At least one Poppy used in the display must be in original form and color, with label attached. This applies to all three (3) categories listed above.
- \*See the VFW's "Buddy"® Poppy Chairman's Guide for rules, deadlines, judging and awards of the National "Buddy"® Poppy Contest, as well as other helpful resources. The guide can be found at <a href="https://www.vfwauxiliary.org/resources">vfwauxiliary.org/resources</a>.
- \*Continue to incorporate the "Buddy"® Poppy in all your programs. Here are a few examples:
- \*Americanism—Decorate your spring and summer wreaths with flags and poppies.
- \*Historian Media Relations—Include poppies in all your upcoming spring and summer photos. The Story does not end on April 15th.
- \*Hospital—Plan Spring and Summer events for a local VAMC and/or nursing home. Decorate your fun activity tables with poppies. The poppy reminds us that we have not forgotten Our Heroes.
- \*Membership—Have plenty of poppies on hand at your next recruitment event. The poppy is recognized in our community as our memorial flower & brands us as to who we are & what we do.
- \*Veterans and Family Support—With warmer temperatures, it is the perfect time of year to host a Military Mental Health Awareness event using the slogan: "22-A Day". Make sure you share all the VFW resources with your local Veterans. Also, set up a "Buddy"® Poppy Drive table.
- \*Youth Activities—Our FUTURE! Educate local youth groups about the history of the "Buddy"® Poppy. Ask the leader if you can speak to the group about our memorial flower. Create an activity for the youth to participate in, like making cards for our hospitalized veterans with poppies.

All this and more will bring awareness to our "Mighty Little Flower"
