What are considered Gold Star Families?





Initiated during World War I, the title **Gold Star** distinguishes a family member who lost a loved one in military service. Today, immediate family members (parent, sibling, spouse, or child) receive a **Gold Star** from the Department of Defense, to honor those who made the ultimate sacrifice. Held the last Sunday in September.

What does a **Blue Star** Family mean?





Silver Star Families
banner
represents a family
member who was
injured, wounded
or became ill during
or as a result of
combat.

Today, families display these banners when they have a loved one serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. The **Blue Star** represents one family member serving, and a banner can have up to five stars. If the individual is killed or dies, a smaller **Golden Star** is placed over it.
