VFW-Based Veterans Assistance Programs

- a. Reach out to your Veteran Service Officers (VSO) for information if "your" veterans are not receiving benefits or have a question about their current benefits.
 - i. Here is the email address for our State Service Officers: serviceofficer@vfwmd.org
- b. National Veterans Service (NVS) helps veterans, service members and their families and survivors FREE OF CHARGE!
- c. Military Assistance Program (MAP) provides help to get our veterans back on their feet. Do you have information posted at your Post, on your Facebook page or in accessible community locations such as libraries, grocery stores and Post Officers? Make sure to ask permission before posting the information.

<u>Housing expenses</u> - mortgage, rent, repairs, and homeowners' insurance (establishing residence/insurance or paying off expenses for a residence that is no longer being occupied will not be considered).

<u>Vehicle expenses</u> – payments, repairs, insurance (purchasing/paying off loan, major repairs for vehicles over 10 years old, registering, establishing insurance will not be considered).

<u>Utilities</u> (establishing/paying off utilities for a residence no longer being occupied will not be considered).

Childcare and

Medical bills (the patient's portion for necessary or emergency medical care only).

Did you Serve in the Armed Forces?

You are a veteran if you are a former military service member or a National Guard Member or Reservist who served on active military duty. Your character, training, and skills are valued by businesses.

Priority of Service at Maryland's American Job Centers

This means that veterans and eligible spouses, who meet the eligibility requirement, will be given access to employment, training, and placement services at an earlier time or before persons who are not eligible for Priority of Service.

What Services are Available?

Examples of specific programs and services available include:

Maryland's Commitment to Veterans (MCV)

(1-800-273-8255, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week) is a program under the Maryland Department of Health. MCV assists veterans and their families with coordinating behavioral health services, including mental health and substance use disorder, with either the VA or Department of Health.

Maryland Higher Education Commission

serves as a State Approving Agency (SAA) for the Department of Veterans Affairs to grant approval for post-secondary institutions and training establishments accepting G.I. Bill education benefits for a veteran, reservist, and/or dependent enrolled in their institutions.

Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) works

with partners to finance housing opportunities and revitalize places for Maryland citizens to live, work, and prosper. DHCD's Maryland Mortgage Program offers a variety of loans with great rates and generous down payment and settlement cost assistance for veterans and military families.

The Warriors to Work program provides career guidance and support services to Wounded Warriors interested in transitioning to the civilian workforce. An individual's skills and experience are matched to the needs of hiring managers. These services are also open to registered family members and caregivers.

Helmets to Hardhats program connects men and women from the Armed Forces with quality career opportunities in the construction industry. Maryland Department of Labor works in partnership with the Department of Veterans Affairs providing services facilitating transition to employment.

Troops to Energy Jobs is designed to help veterans make a successful move to a rewarding career in the energy industry.

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) is

a Federal tax credit available to employers who hire veterans and individuals from other eligible target groups with significant barriers to employment.

The Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs

is a State Government Executive Department with a service mission to assist veterans, active duty service members, their families and dependents, in securing benefits earned through military service. Under the Department of Veterans Affairs are five major programs: the Veterans Cemetery and Memorial Program; Charlotte Hall Veterans Home; the Veterans Service and Benefits Program; Outreach and Advocacy Program; and the Maryland Veterans Trust

The Military Personnel and Veteran-Owned Small Business Loan Program is administered by the Maryland Department of Commerce in consultation with the Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs. The program provides no-interest loans to members called to active duty, Military reservists, National Guard, service-disabled veterans, and businesses which employ or are owned by such persons.

ONE-ON-ONE ASSISTANCE

Veterans' Services at Maryland's American Job Centers

American Job Centers offer a variety of services to assist veterans. transitioning military personnel, and other qualified individuals. Veterans and other eligible persons may also receive one-on-one assistance. Local Veterans Employment Representatives (LVERs) develop hiring opportunities within the local areas by contacting businesses, Federal agencies and contractors, and employer associations to encourage the hiring and advancement of qualified veterans. Disabled Veterans' Outreach Program (DVOP) staff provide specialized intensive employment assistance to eligible veterans who have special employment and training needs. The DVOPs assist individuals to overcome barriers that prevent them from gaining meaningful employment. DVOPs apply a case management approach and access a broad network of providers and resources to assist eligible veterans with their employment goals.






