Where Needed Most

"Where Needed Most" tops the list of funds needing donations because these unrestricted gifts provide the National Home with the greatest flexibility. These gifts will be used for whatever is needed most at the time. They ensure we can continue to provide professional counseling, tutoring, health care, licensed childcare and other support services to the families and their children living at the National Home.

Campus Maintenance Fund

This fund covers all expenses associated with operating and maintaining the facilities and grounds (except for sponsored buildings and houses).

Early Education Center Fund – (Daycare/Preschool)

Your donation to this fund will help pay for the expenses associated with operating our licensed daycare/preschool EEC (Early Education Center) not covered by sponsorship.


