Many of our high school, middle school and elementary schools offer community services after school programs (clubs) and that most colleges today look at community involvement on their applications. These after-school programs offer us as Auxiliary members a way to engage with our community youth. Below are some ideas on how to promote our Youth Activities Program with some of our other amazing programs. Team up with other Chairmen to get working on these suggestions or others like them.

- **Reading Buddies:** Reading Buddies is a little different than previous years because we changed the rules. Any Auxiliary member can be a Reading Buddy, which is you listening to our children read. Please continue to promote and use the book lists available on MALTA, as well as donating books to local schools and libraries. Don't forget to talk to the librarian or principal when you make the donation to see if you can lend a hand to some of our struggling readers. I also encourage hosting a Reading Buddy event at the Post on a cold day. What goes better together than a hot chocolate and a good book on a cold day. Just remember to get all the proper waivers signed; this is also a way to show our community that we are more than a canteen.
- **Youth Groups:** Working with our youth brings me an immense amount of joy and I know that we can make a difference in the life of a child. We can show them what it means to be a good person and how to give back to the community, and we can guarantee that one day they will remember the VFW Auxiliary and will want to be a part of something special. Start calling your local schools or after school program leaders to see where you can give an assist for the win.

• **Illustrating America:** The Illustrating America Contest is once again a gateway to our communities. Through our youth we can show their parents and families what we do for our veterans, military, community and families. This is also a terrific way to introduce our artists to our Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest, just another way to tie two great initiatives together.
