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What is it?

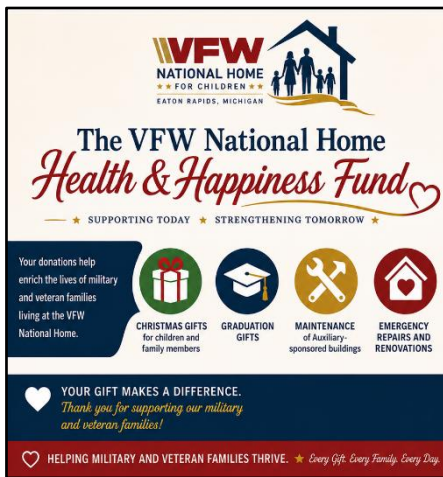
The VFW National Home is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that has formed a community to assist military members, veterans, and their families. It was founded in 1925 in Eaton Rapids MI and has 43 individual houses plus many other facilities like a gym, a library, a day care center and much more. The National Home takes no government funding, relying on donations to fulfill its mission. That mission is to help each family living at the Home reach their full potential. Families can live there rent-free for up to 4 years. During that time, they have a professional case manager and access to life skills training, tutoring and other educational services, support groups, licensed childcare and more. The VFW National Home is open to families of service members, veterans and descendants of members of the VFW and it's auxiliary. The family can be one or both parents and one or more children.



What is the focus of our VFW National Home Program?

1. Educate our members about the Home and all it has to offer.
 2. Help fill all the 43 homes available.
 3. Raise additional funding to build more homes.
 4. Get the word out and encourage those in need to call and reach out for help.

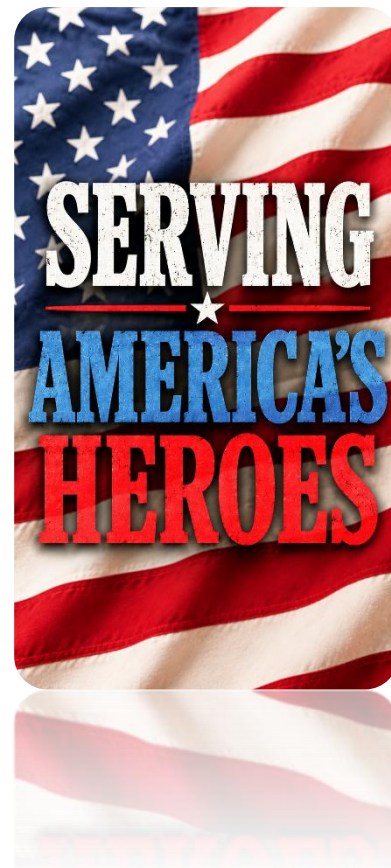
